Who can apply for a TECHNO scholarship?

All levels of mobility are eligible: Bachelors, Masters, Doctorates, Post-doctorates, Academic and Scientific Staff.

- Person who are registered at one of the Asian partner universities at the time of submitting their application to the partnership. Undergraduate students must have successfully completed at least one year of studies in their home institution;

- Who are being registered in a HEI (not included in the partnership) of Asian countries concerned by the lot or having obtained a university degree or equivalent by an institution of these third-countries ;

- Who are nationals of one of the Asian countries concerned by the lot and be part of the vulnerable target groups.

The field of study must be related to the TECHNO topics: Engineering, Agriculture, Health, Life Sciences, Physics, Chemistry, Earth Sciences. www.techno-em.org provides all information concerning the program and the procedure to apply for a TECHNO scholarship.

Eligible candidates must apply on the TECHNO website to make an application. Once the application has been registered, the applicants will have to upload all mandatory documents.
